Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C seeking the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.66 dated 1.5.2013 under sections 21, 61, 85 of N.D.P.S Act, registered at Police Station, Model Town, Hosiarpur.

Counsel for the petitioner has been heard at length.

Pleadings on record would reflect that inspite of having been granted bail the petitioner did not appear before the Trial Court and as such, non-bailable warrants to ensure his presence had been issued. The petitioner, at that point of time, had approached this Court by filing CRM No. M-17962 of 2014 and vide order dated 23.5.2014 concession of interim bail was granted subject to the petitioner joining trial proceedings. Counsel would concede that even though, indulgence had been shown but the petitioner did not appear before the Trial Court.

Petitioner yet again is guilty of evading the process of law and the Trial Court has issued non-bailable warrants of the petitioner vide orders dated 9.12.2015 and 25.12.2015. Thereafter, even proclamation proceedings under section 82 Cr.P.C stand initiated.

Conduct of the petitioner is such that no indulgence can be shown to him. Prayer seeking concession of pre-arrest bail is, accordingly, declined.

Petition is dismissed.
