This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.93 dated 21.06.2014 registered under Sections 302/324/148/149 IPC and Sections 25/27/54/59 Arms Act at Police Station Majitha, District Amritsar (Rural).

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has been in custody since June 2014. There is a cross case and evidence in that cross case is yet to begin.

Learned Deputy Advocate General on instructions from ASI Parshotam has accepted these facts but states that this is not a case of circumstantial evidence or blind murder but a case of direct evidence.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that as per his version it was the other side which attacked him.

Without commenting on the merits of the arguments of either side and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has been in custody for more than 2 years and 3 months and the fact that the trial in the cross case is not likely to be concluded in the near future, I deem it appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Ordered accordingly.

Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
