Prayer made in the instant petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of FIR No.172 dated 26.05.2013 for offence under Sections 409 and 420 IPC, registered at Police Station Hathin, Distt. Palwal (Annexure P-3) and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

Previous orders shows that counsel for the petitioner has not put in appearance on different dates i.e. on 17.11.2014, 03.11.2015 and 08.01.2016. Even today nobody has entered appearance on behalf of the petitioner.

On the other hand learned counsel for the State submits that since the petitioner has been discharged in the case vide judgment dated 05.06.2014, present petition has been rendered infructuous and it is probably in these circumstances, counsel for the petitioner is not putting in appearance since November 17, 2014.

Dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
