FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

It is inter alia argued by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the similarly placed co-accused Shehbaz Singh has been allowed bail by this Court vide order dated 11.7.2016 and that the case of the petitioner is not distinguishable from that of his co-accused as the only allegation against them are of having impersonated on the basis of Khakhi Turban and posing themselves as police officials. It is duly conceded by the learned State counsel that nothing is to be recovered from the petitioner.

In view thereof and keeping in view that trial is not likely to be concluded in near future and no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind the bars, without adverting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition for grant of regular bail is allowed.

Petitioner be admitted to bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
