This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.132 dated 27.09.2015 registered under Sections 148/149/302/323/506/120-B IPC at Police Station Saha, District Ambala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in this case the complainant while appearing as witness has improved the version and has now stated that the petitioner caught hold of the deceased whereas there were no such allegation in the FIR. The petitioner has been in custody since 28.09.2015 and an application under Section 319 Cr.P.C. has been allowed and the accused who allegedly gave the injury is in jail. He further states that the co-accused namely Ravi who had also not been attributed any injury to the deceased has been granted concession of regular bail vide CRM-M-16860 of 2016 on 14.07.2016.

Learned Deputy Advocate General, on instructions from ASI Ram Karan has accepted these factual assertions.

Keeping in view the above facts and the period of incarceration already suffered by the petitioner, without going into the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Ordered accordingly.

Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
