The petitioner has been in custody w.e.f. 3.12.2014 allegedly having been found in possession of 310 grams of intoxicating powder containing Alprazolam.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the procedure adopted for investigation and search in the present case is violative of provision of law and that provisions of Section 50 of the NDPS Act have not been complied with.

I have considered the facts of the case with the assistance of counsel for the petitioner and State counsel and gone through the record of the case. It has been informed that nine witnesses out of eleven witnesses sand examined. Next date of hearing before the trial Court is stated to be 5.4.2016.

This petition is disposed of with a direction that prosecution agency shall make earnest endeavor to conclude the entire remaining evidence within a period of two months after the next date of hearing. In case, trial is not concluded within a total period of four months after the next date of hearing, the trial Court shall release the petitioner on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to its satisfaction.
