1. *Whether Reporters of local papers may be allowed to see the judgment?*

NARESH KUMAR SANGHI, J. (Oral)

Learned counsel for the petitioners prays for withdrawal of the present petition to enable the petitioners to take all the pleas before learned Court below at an appropriate state. He further submits that personal appearance of the petitioners on each date of hearing before learned Trial Court may also be exempted.

Learned counsel for the respondents have no objection to the prayer for withdrawal of the present petition, but they have objected to the prayer for grant of exemption to

the petitioners from personal appearance on each date of hearing before learned Trial Court.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, the petitioners are permitted to withdraw the present petition with liberty to take all the pleas before learned Trial Court at an appropriate stage.

In case the petitioners move an application for grant of exemption from personal appearance before learned Trial Court on each date of hearing, the same shall be considered in view of the fact that the case is pending for approximately 1½ year and other grounds to be mentioned in the application.
