Through the instant petition, the petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.0046 dated 11.05.2016, registered under Sections 363, 366-A, 376, 120-B IPC and Section 4 & 16 of Prevention of Children from Sexual Offences Act, Police Station Kotwali, Nabha, Distt. Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that pursuant to the interim order date 10.08.2016, passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation and have cooperated.
