Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that present petition has been rendered infructuous as accused has been acquitted by the trial court. A status report has also been filed on behalf of U.T., Chandigarh. Para 6 thereof reads as under:-

“That this Hon'ble Court by its order dated 19.11.2015 further directed the Ld trial court to proceed with the trial and record evidence and also vacated the stay granted on passing of the final order. As a consequence thereof, the trial court has concluded and the Ld trial court has entered a judgment of acquittal against all the accused remaining by its judgment dated 30.4.2016.”
