Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.109 dated 12.07.2016 under Sections 323, 379, 427, 506, 148, 149 IPC (Section 325 IPC added lateron), registered at Police Station Sultanpur Lodhi, District Kapurthala.

This Court vide order dated 10.08.2016, while issuing notice of motion, has granted interim bail to the petitioners subject to joining the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Sukhdev Singh, submits that so far as petitioner No.1 is concerned, he has been found innocent during investigation, whereas petitioner No.2-Raja Coach son of Kirpal Singh has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 19.10.2016 are made absolute.

However, the petitioner No.2 shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
