Heard learned counsel for the parties. The only ground
of rejection of the application for anticipatory bail in Para-7 of the
impugned order is that all the offences being bailable, the
application was not maintainable. FIR shows that offence under
Section 353 of IPC was also registered against the petitioner and
that is non-bailable. Hence, the Additional Sessions Judge,
Ludhiana, to decide the application on merits within 15 days, from
the receipt of this order. Till then the petitioner shall remain on Ad-
interim order of anticipatory bail, in the event of arrest, subject to
satisfaction of Investigating Officer.
