The petitioner is alleged to be the person to whom the liquor belongs, which was allegedly recovered from the vehicle. Since he was not arrested from the spot, his involvement, culpability and identity will be a debatable issue.

Accordingly, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 7.1.2016 is hereby confirmed and it is ordered that in case of arrest of the petitioner, he will be released on bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer subject to the condition that he will join the investigation as and when required by the police and will not tamper with evidence or hamper the investigation. The petitioner will not commit the similar offence, of which he is accused of, during pendency of the trial. In case of any such eventuality, it will be open to the prosecution agency to seek cancellation of bail.
