Present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. has been filed for issuance of a direction to the Arresting Officer to release the petitioner on bail in the event of his arrest in FIR No.6 dated 30.06.2016, under Section 406 IPC registered at Police Station NRI, Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar.

In compliance of order dated 10.08.2016, the petitioner has joined the investigation on 09.09.2016. In the present case, the dispute arose between the parties on account of money amounting to Rs.13.75 lacs. The locker in the name of petitioner was operated and thereafter the locker in the name of the present petitioner and his father will be transferred in the name of Poonam Kesar as they are residing in Italy together. After the compromise, the parties did not go back Italy. In this background, locker was operated by the petitioner and his father. It is not in dispute between the parties that after the compromise (Annexure P-2), the locker was operated on 11.09.2016 and checked by the petitioner and there is nothing

in the locker as on today. The complainant is in Italy and the allegation is with regard to the misappropriation of dowry articles.

In view of the above, order dated 10.08.2016 is made absolute subject to the petitioner to give an FDR in the sum of Rs.5 lacs in the name of respondent No.2, which will be disbursed at the time of final decision by the Area Magistrate

In view of the above, the present petition stands disposed of accordingly.
