By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioners have sought anticipatory bail in FIR No.395, dated 04.12.2014, registered under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC, at Police Station Tripuri Patiala, District Patiala.

On 10.08.2016, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Petitioners along with Balkar Singh had alleged extended time of the target date of sale on the agreement of sale from March 31, 2012 to May 5, 2013 and have allegedly cheated the complainant by fabricating the document.

Notice to Advocate General, Punjab, for September

13, 2016.

Meanwhile, an interim direction is issued that the petitioners will join investigation on August 20, 2016 and in case of their doing so, they will be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer.”

It is contended that in pursuance of the order dated 10.08.2016, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel, on instructions submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation and they are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 10.08.2016, is made absolute, subject to furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

The petition stands allowed.
