JASPAL SINGH, J.

This petition has been preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing the cross version DDR No.7, dated 06.07.2008, under Sections 325, 323, 148, 149 of IPC and Section 201 added later on and FIR No. 53, dated 06.07.2008, under Sections 323, 324, 148, 149 of IPC, registered at Police Station Ganaur, District Patiala along with all consequential proceedings arising out of the same on the basis of compromise.

2. In compliance of order dated November 03, 2015, report of learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Rajpura, has been received,

in which, it has been categorically observed that parties have arrived at compromise with their free coercion, without any pressure or voluntarily from any quarter. Even otherwise, matter involved is personal in nature, which has been amicably put at rest.

3. In view of the above I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for their benefit and will bring peace and harmony between them.

4. Consequently, instant petition stands allowed and the cross version DDR No.7, dated 06.07.2008, under Sections 325, 323, 148, 149 of IPC and Section 201 added later on and FIR No. 53, dated 06.07.2008, under Sections 323, 324, 148, 149 of IPC, registered at Police Station Ganaur, District Patiala and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are quashed qua the petitioners.
