Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.540 dated 18.09.2014 under Sections 406, 419, 467, 468, 471, 506 and 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Sector-7, Faridabad.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr.Vikramjit Singh, Addl. Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepted notice on behalf of the respondent-State and contested the petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

Police record is also available.

From the record, I find that as per the FIR, a complaint was

allegations regarding cheating have been levelled against them for cheating so many people. These Developers had no land for plotting nor the requisite CLU from the Government Department is in the name of company.

Learned counsel for the petitioner argued that the present petitioner is named in the FIR. The main accused Avneet Rawat has already been granted bail by learned JMIC, Faridabad on 03.02.2016.

The petitioner is in custody since 04.04.2016. He is not required for investigation or interrogation purposes. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case, without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal/surety bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
