This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.82 dated 21.05.2013, registered under Section 21 of the Mines and Minerals Act (Development and Regulations) and Section 379 IPC, at P.S. Meharbaan, Ludhiana City.

After arguing for some time, the learned counsel for the

petitioner states that he does not wish to press this petition on merits but

liberty may be granted to the petitioner to surrender before the Court below and move an application for regular bail explaining the circumstances because of which he could not appear in the Court and a direction may be issued to the Court to decide the said application expeditiously.

I find this to be a fair request. Let the petitioner surrender before the Court below on or before 16.08.2016 and move an application for regular bail which shall be decided expeditiously by the Court but in any case on or before 20.08.2016.

Petition stands dismissed as having been not pressed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
