ANITA CHAUDHRY, J.

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 36 dated 10.11.2015, registered under Sections 376, 342 IPC and Section 4 of POCSO Act, Women Police Station Kaithal, District Kaithal.

The counsel for the petitioner contends that all material witnesses have been examined.

The State counsel says that out of 19 witnesses 11 witnesses have been examined.

The counsel for the petitioner urges that no human semen was detected and the trial will end in acquittal as the claim stands falsified.

The State counsel urges that the girl was only 14 – 15 years old and the prosecutrix has deposed against the petitioner.

The trial is going at a fast pace. The allegations against the

petitioner are serious. No case for bail is made out. The petition is dismissed.
