The probate petition was ordered to be listed for 18.08.2015 for evidence of the petitioners after counsel for the petitioners made a statement at bar that the civil suit has already been dismissed. Since then, the proceedings have been adjourned for more than 5 occasions awaiting an action on part of the petitioners for submitting the list of witnesses and process fee but yielded no result. Despite grant of last opportunity, counsel for the petitioners failed to do the needful.

Counsel for the petitioners has submitted that despite repeated efforts, they could not get in touch with the petitioners for necessary compliance.

As the petitioners have failed to comply with the directions issued by this Court despite repeated orders, there is no option left, except to put the proceedings to an end.

The probate petition is dismissed accordingly.
