Prayer made in the instant petition is, inter alia, for quashing of order dated 11.04.2016 (Annexure P-3) passed by respondent No.2, thereby consigning complainant of the petitioner on the ground that the petitioner did not want to get the investigation done on his complaint.

Learned counsel refers to the statement of the petitioner dated 11.04.2016, which was not appreciated by the SHO, who recorded the incorrect finding that the petitioner is not interested in the investigation by the police. Against the said order, the petitioner has moved representation before respondent No.1 and the same is pending consideration.

Heard.

Having regard to the prayer made and the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to issue notice of motion to the respondents.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the

instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1, to consider and decide the representation moved by the petitioner in accordance with law, expeditiously, preferably, within a period of three weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
