Petitioners-Shashi Syal wife of late Ashok Syal and Sumit Syal son of late Ashok Syal, residents of 1067, Urban Estate, Phase-I, Jalandhar, have filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of complaint No.284/07, dated 01.10.2007 (Annexure P-3) titled as "Smt. Ramesh Rani Versus Syal Leasing Limited and others" filed by respondent No.2 against the petitioners. Challenge has also been made to the order dated 05.10.2007 (Annexure P-4) whereby the petitioners were summoned for offence under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act.

For the last three consecutive hearings i.e. 26.09.2011, 10.01.2012 and 05.03.2012, no one is appearing on behalf of the petitioners. Even as per the status available on the official website of Sessions Court, Jalandhar, it transpires that the complainant has withdrawn the complaint.

The withdrawal of the complaint reflects that no cause of action survives for the petitioners in the present petition and, therefore, they are not appearing in Court.

Accordingly, the petition is dismissed for want of prosecution.
