HARI PAL VERMA, J. (ORAL)

Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 & 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No. 4 to 7.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners have solemnized their marriage on 03.08.2016 according to Sikh rites and rituals. However, respondents No.4 to 7 are not accepting their marriage and are adamant to separate them from each other by resorting to illegal means.

Learned counsel further submits that in view of imminent danger to the life and liberty of the petitioners, they had moved a representation dated 03.08.2016 (Annexure P-4) to respondent No.2 i.e. the Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran.

Learned State counsel on the other hand, states that since the petitioner No.1 is minor, the marriage of the petitioners is voidable.

Heard.

Without going into the validity of the marriage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to take appropriate remedial measures, as warranted by law, on the representation 03.08.2016 (Annexure P-4) submitted by the petitioners.

In the meantime, necessary order be passed to ensure that no harm is caused to the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.4 to 7.
