Ritu Bahri J. (Oral) :

This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in Complaint case No.2-01 dated 6.1.2014 under Sections 406, 498A, 323 and 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar, Jalalabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in compliance of order dated 11.8.2016, the petitioner has appeared before the trial Court and his bond/surety bonds have since been accepted vide order dated 24.8.2016.

At this stage, Mr. Ajit Singh Sodhi, Advocate, has put in appearance for respondent No. 1 and state that the matter be referred for mediation for amicable settlement.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances of the case, order dated 11.8.2016, passed by this Court, whereby the petitioner was directed to appear before the trial Court and submit his bail bonds and the trial Court

shall accept the same, is made absolute and direction is given to the trial Court that efforts be made to resolve the matter amicably.

Accordingly, the petition stands disposed of.
