Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and not to harass them at the instance of respondent Nos.4 to 7.

Mr. Gaurav Grover, Advocate has entered appearance on behalf of the respondent No.4 and prays that parents of the petitioner No.1 may kindly be allowed to meet her.

Allowed as prayed for. After meeting her parents in my

chamber, the petitioner No.1 states that she wants to go with her husband petitioner No.2.

The petitioners have got married against the wishes of their parents. They are stated to be major. In support of her proof of age petitioner No.1 has placed on record a copy of Matriculation Examination Certificate (Annexure P-1) wherein her date of birth is mentioned as 05.04.1996 whereas petitioner No.2 has placed on record a copy of Aadhar Card (Annexure P-2) depicting his year of birth as 1989. They have also moved a representation before the SSP, Patiala (Annexure P-5) for protection of their life and liberty.

Without adverting to the merits of the controversy, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-the SSP, Patiala to take appropriate action on the said representation (Annexure P-5).

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
