INDERJIT SINGH, J.

This petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for brevity, 'Cr.P.C.') for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.223 dated 10.07.2016, registered at Police Station Pinjore, under Sections 323, 379, 506 and 34 IPC.

Notice of motion has been issued in this case.

Mr. Vikramjit Singh, Additional Advocate General, Haryana has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the present FIR has been registered

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under Sections 323, 379 and 506 IPC. The allegation qua Section 379 IPC is that the present petitioner snatched ear rings and chain from the neck of the complainant. The complainant got recovered her ear rings from the spot.

In pursuance of the interim order dated 11.08.2016 passed by this Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation. She is not required for custodial interrogation.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case and no useful purpose will be served by sending the petitioner to custody, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 11.08.2016, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
