This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 67 dated 9.5.2014 under Sections 323/324/325/326/148/149 IPC at Police Station Sultanpur Lodhi, District Kapurthala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that on the last date of hearing following contention was noticed:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner states that injury under Section 326 IPC was not attributed to the petitioner.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Amarjit Kaur Khurana, Addl. AG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Learned counsel for the petitioner undertakes to supply a copy of the petition to the learned Additional Advocate General, Punjab during the course of the day. Adjourned to 24.08.2016.”

Ms. Amarjit Kaur Khurana, learned Additional Advocate

General, Punjab on instructions from Head Constable Subag Singh has accepted these factual assertions.

Be that as it may, in the circumstances, keeping in view the above facts, without commenting on the merits of the case, let the petitioner surrender before the Investigating officer on 6.9.2016 and the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so and he shall remain bound by the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

Ordered accordingly.

Petition stands allowed.
