Petitioner is seeking direction to respondent Nos. 1 and 2 to enquire the matter related to case FIR No. 369 dated 17.07.2016 under Sections 365, 323 and 506 IPC and Section 6 of POCSO Act, registered at Police Station Shahdad through Special Investigation Team or any Senior Police Official at least from the rank of DCP deputed outside from District Kurukshetra in the light of Annexure P-3.

Upon notice, reply has been filed by DSP, Shahbad on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3 and it is stated that after registration of the FIR, investigation was carried out and statement of witnesses were recorded on 17.07.2016. On 17.07.2016 missing Amandeep Kaur was found at Dayal Nagar, Shahbad. The statement of Amandeep Kaur was got recorded under Section 164 Cr.P.C. and Section 6 of POCSO Act and Section 323, 506 IPC were added in the FIR. The prosecutrix stated that Chotu, Aakash son of the petitioner and Sahil had taken her from near of her house under fear of killing her father if she does not

come along with them. All three persons have committed wrong act with her and also given beatings. After conducting the medical the allegations were found cogent. Akash Deep was arrested on 19.07.2016. His date of birth was found to be 24.12.1999. He was 16 years 07 months 22 days. He was produced before Presiding Officer, Juvenile Justice Board. After completion of the investigation the other accused has been arrested on 10.10.2016 and report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. Submitted against him

The search of other accused person was made but they did not find him.

In view of the reply, no further directions are required in this case.

Petition stands disposed of.
