This is a petition for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.106, dated 28.08.2013 registered under Sections 420/467/468/471/120-B IPC at Police Station Lopoke, Amritsar Rural, District Amritsar.

As per the allegation the petitioner alongwith some persons duped the complainant by selling him land by producing some imposters. It is not disputed that at one stage the petitioner also issued cheques to the complainant to refund the money illegally taken and those cheques were also dishonoured. As per the FIR it was the petitioner who was one of the persons instrumental in duping the complainant.

In view of this conduct, I do not deem it appropriate to continue the interim order dated 08.08.2014.

Resultantly the same is vacated and the petition is dismissed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
