FATEH DEEP SINGH, J (ORAL)

Allegations against the petitioner Sandeep in this regular bail petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. are that on 19.04.2015 had fired three shots in the air to intimidate Kuldeep complainant.

Contentions of the learned counsel for the petitioner that it is a non-injury case and that the petitioner is in custody since 14.05.2015 and that the investigation and trial is likely to take long time. Though the factual aspect is not disputed by learned State counsel.

Keeping in view the incarceration being a non-injury case and the fact that the investigations and trial will take a long time to conclude and culpability if any shall be determined during trial, this Court is of the opinion that further detention of the petitioner in the present case is unwarranted. Accordingly, he is ordered to be released on

regular bail to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate, Rohtak.

The present petition stands disposed off accordingly.
