Present case under FIR No. 3 dated 03.01.2014 under Section 21 of the NDPS Act was registered at Police Station City Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran against the petitioner on the basis of secret information but recovery was effected after his arrest on the basis of his disclosure statement made in custody. 180 days after his arrest expired on 07.07.2014. By said date, the trial Court did not decide the application for extension of time under section 36-A (4) of the NDPS Act which had been filed by the prosecution agency in time.

In case bearing CRM-M-27961-2014, application of the co-accused namely Harvinder Singh @ Rimple, in the similar circumstances, has been allowed. Petitioner, already being on interim

bail, it is ordered that he will remain on bail against the bail bonds already furnished by him subject to the condition that he will not indulge in similar activity during the pendency of the trial. Petition is allowed.
