Petitioner claims that she was married to Atinder Pal Singh on 12.02.2012 who is an NRI and at present residing in U.S.A. It is claimed that being not happy with the marriage which was against the wishes of the parents of the petitioner, she is being threatened by her father and is compelled to get divorce from her husband.

The petitioner has filed a representation to Senior Superintendent of Police, District Gurdaspur. Copy of the representation has been appended as Annexure P-3.

Notice to Advocate General, Punjab.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Simsi Dhir Malhotra, DAG, Punjab, present in the Court, accepts notice. Copy given.

Without expression of any opinion on merits regarding the averments made in representation, I deem it appropriate to dispose of this petition in limine with a direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, District Gurdaspur to look into the allegations of the petitioner in Annexure

P-3 and if the allegations are found to be correct on inquiry, necessary steps be taken to prevent any breach of peace or threat to the life and liberty of the petitioner. It will be appreciated in case application Annexure P-3 is considered within a period of two months after the receipt of copy of this order.
