Petitioner has been in custody w.e.f. 9.5.2016, in a case registered at the instance of Sanjeev Sharma, alleging that on 8.5.2016, Akhilesh Kumar, Arvind Kumar, Rohit Kumar, Neeraj and 15-20 other people trespassed into the house of brother of complainant Rajiv Sharma and caused injuries on his head.

So far as petitioner is concerned, he allegedly had an altercation with Rajiv Sharma regarding parking of the vehicle. Though the matter has been compromised but later on the above said incident had taken place. Petitioner has not been attributed any specific injury on the person of Rajiv Sharma. Challan has already been presented. The trial is likely to take a long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the accused in custody during the entire period of trial.

The petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
