This is a petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of regular bail in FIR No.165 dated 11.09.2015 registered under Sections 323, 324, 341, 506, 379, 148 and 308 read with Section 149 IPC at Police Station Division No.4, Ludhiana, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the co-accused Sonu Gawala stands admitted to bail vide order dated 25.07.2016 passed in CRM M-24133 of 2016 (Annexure P-3). The petitioner is in custody since 21.11.2015. It is further contended that the petitioner is not named in the FIR. No overt act has been attributed to the petitioner.

Considering the fact that the petitioner is neither named in the FIR nor any specific injury has been attributed to the petitioner, the petitioner is in custody since 21.11.2015, the challan stands presented,

out of 16 prosecution witnesses, not even a single prosecution witness has been examined so far, therefore, it can be safely concluded that the conclusion of trial will take a long time, so, the instant petition is allowed and it is the ordered that the petitioner be admitted to bail to the the satisfaction of trial Court.
