This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C., for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.19 dated 09.03.2015, registered at Police Station Khem Karan, District Tarn Taran, under Sections 302, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner is in custody for 01 year and 05 months and even the complainant has not been examined so far.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Kuldeep Ram, states that the complainant has been summoned to give his testimony day after tomorrow i.e. on 15.10.2016. Learned counsel for the complainant-eye

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witness also states that the complainant shall definitely appear to give his testimony.

In these circumstances, the instant petition stands dismissed at this stage. However, if the complainant does not appear on the next date of hearing before the learned trial Court to give his testimony, the petitioner would be at liberty to apply for bail afresh.
