At the very outset, learned counsel states that the name of respondent No.2 has been wrongly described and it should have been described as Superintendent of Police, Ambala and prays that he may be allowed to do necessary correction in the memo of parties.

Allowed as prayed for.

This petition has been filed for seeking direction to

respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and

his family members at the hands of the private respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in this connection the petitioner has also moved representations (Annexure P-5 and P-6) and at this stage he would be satisfied if a direction is given to respondent No.2 to look into the matter and take appropriate action on his representation within any reasonable time.

I find this to be a fair request. The respondent No.2-the S.P., Ambala is directed to look into the matter and in case it is found that any action is required, to take whatever action he deems necessary as per law.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
