withdraw the present petition qua petitioner No.6.

Report dated 10.03.2016 sent by learned Judicial
Magistrate 1st Class, Kapurthala has been received, whereby, after
recording statements of petitioners Gurbhej Singh, Gaurav Bhandari @
Monu, Harjit Singh, Anantpal Singh, Sikander Singh and Amandeep
Singh as well as of complainants Navdeep Singh and Maninder Singh it
has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise
voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure and today
in partial fulfilment of this compromise a sum of ₹2,25,000/- has been
handed over by the petitioners No.1 to 5 to both the complainant which
they have received to their satisfaction and have made statement before

this Court that they do not have any due against the petitioners No.1 to 5.

Keeping in view the same and the fact that parties have effected a compromise for the offences which are not of heinous nature which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052**, FIR No.26 dated 12.03.2014 under Sections 420,406,120-B IPC and Sections 65,66,66B,66C,66D,66E of Information Technology Act, 2000 Police Station, Subhanpur, District Kapurthala and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners No.1 to 5.

Petition stands disposed off.
