INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.401 dated 05.08.2015, registered at Police Station Gharaunda, District Karnal, under Sections 285, 379, 511, 411, 414 and 120-B IPC, Sections 15 and 16 of the Petroleum Minerals and Pipeline Amendment Act, 2011, Sections 3 and 4 of the Prevention of Damage to the Public Property Act, 1984 and Sections 3 and 4 of the Explosive Substances Act.

Notice of motion was issued in this case. Learned State counsel put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

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As per the case of prosecution, there is allegation against the accused that they committed the theft of oil near village Begampur from the pipeline leading from Mathura to Jalandhar.

The present petitioner has been in custody since 12.08.2015. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
