Petitioners seek quashing of FIR No. 180 dated 06.11.2012 under Sections 420, 406 IPC registered at Police Station Phagwara City, District Kapurthala on the basis of compromise.

The said FIR was registered at the instance of respondent No. 2 – Daljit Singh alleging that the petitioners in connivance with each other duped respondent No. 2 for a sum of Rs. 20,50,000/- on the pretext of sending him to Spain on permanent basis. Besides this, the petitioners have allegedly taken away the passport of respondent No. 2.

Respondent No. 2 has put in appearance through counsel to state that the matter has been compromised.

This petition is disposed of with liberty to respondent No. 2 to appear before the investigating officer within a period of two months who will record the supplementary statement, if offered, voluntarily. If any such statement is offered to the investigating officer, who is bound

to record it as per the mandate of Section 163 (2) Cr.P.C., it will be open to the investigating officer to present cancellation report and in said eventuality, the complainant may appear before the Court and agree that the matter has been compromised.
