In FIR No.0082 dated 24.07.2016 registered under Sections 323, 452, 148 and 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 27 of Arms Act, at Police Station Gidderbaha, District Sri Muktsar Sahib, the petitioners are being prosecuted.

Mr. Lalit Tuteja-learned counsel for the complainant states that during the pendency of the petition compromise has been arrived at between the parties. I have also seen the compromise deed (Annexure P-2). This Court had directed the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate to record the statements vide order dated August 12, 2016, in view of the compromise arrived at between the parties and also to verify whether the same is genuine or not. Now, there is a report received from Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Gidderbaha, showing that the statements of the parties have been recorded

and the compromise that is arrived at with the intervention of relatives and respectable persons is genuine and without any coercion or undue influence.

Looking to the nature of the offences registered in FIR and terms of the compromise deed, I think, parties should be allowed to compound/compromise the offences in order that they leave in peace and harmony.

In that view of the matter, FIR No.0082 dated 24.07.2016 registered under Sections 323, 452, 148 and 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 27 of Arms Act, at Police Station Gidderbaha, District Sri Muktsar Sahib is quashed by way of compounding/compromise along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.
