Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C.
for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.42 dated 23.03.2016, registered
at Police Station Canal Colony, District Bathinda, under Sections 399
and 402 IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act.

Notice of motion has been issued in this case.

Ms. Shivali, AAG, Punjab has put in appearance on behalf
of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the present FIR has been

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registered on the basis of secret information that the present petitioner along with other co-accused were preparing to commit any incident and dacoity. As per the prosecution version, one baseball and stolen silver ornaments weighing 600 grams have been recovered from the present petitioner.

The present petitioner has been in custody since 23.03.2016. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. Nothing is to be recovered from the present petitioner. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
