This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.111 dated 04.07.2015, registered under Sections 18, 21, 61, 85 of the NDPS Act, at Police Station City Kotkapura, District Faridkot.

Today the learned Deputy Advocate General on instructions

from H.C. Harminder Singh states that 2 out of 11 witnesses have already

been examined and undertakes that the prosecution will lead its entire evidence on or before 16.12.2016 and till such time bail should not be granted to the petitioner.

I find this to be a fair submission. In the circumstances, in view of the undertaking given by the learned Deputy Advocate General, it is directed that in case the prosecution does not lead its entire evidence on or before 16.12.2016 (subject to the accused not obstructing the same), the petitioner be released on bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
