Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.164 dated 15.07.2016 under Sections 15/27A of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Jakhal, District Fatehabad.

This Court vide order dated 12.08.2016, while issuing notice of motion, has granted interim bail to the petitioner subject to joining investigation on 20.08.2016 and 10.09.2016, but on account of the fact that his son was admitted in the hospital, he could not join investigation and vide order dated 05.10.2016 passed by this Court, he was directed to appear before the Investigating Officer on 06.10.2016 and join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant to orders dated 12.08.2016 and 05.10.2016, petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instruction from ASI Rudra Krishan, submits that in terms of aforesaid orders, petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and interim directions issued by this Court vide orders dated 12.08.2016 and 05.10.2016 are made absolute.

However, petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
