This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C for anticipatory bail of the petitioner in case FIR No. 82 dated 16.7.2015 under Sections 420/467/468/471/506/120-B IPC at Police Station City Fazilka, District Fazilka.

The status report in the form of affidavit of Shubeg Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Fazilka has been filed. The same is taken on record.

As the the FIR the allegations against the petitioner are that son of the petitioner had obtained money on false pretenses from the complainant by way of security. The petitioner had executed an agreement to sell. However, neither son of the petitioner returned the money nor the petitioner had executed the sale deed.

Ms. Amarjit Kaur Khurana, Additional Advocate General, Punjab., on instructions from the ASI Krishan Lal accepts this fact and states that further interrogation of the petitioner is not necessary.

Be that as it may, in the circumstances, keeping in view the above facts, without commenting on the merits of the case, the interim order dated 3.9.2015 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

The Criminal Misc. petition stands disposed of.

If the complainant has some rights under the agreement to sell she would be at liberty to enforce them by way of appropriate remedy.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
