Prayer in this petition under Section 482 of Criminal Procedure Code on behalf of accused-Mohd. Asgar alias Asrar (petitioner No. 1 herein) and his father Mohd. Gafoor (petitioner No. 2 herein), is for quashing of FIR No. 62, dated 05.07.2015, for offences punishable under Sections 323, 324, 34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 326 of the Indian Penal Code added later on, registered at Police Station City Malerkotla, District Sangrur (**Annexure P-1**) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 16.07.2015 (**Annexure P-2**) with the complainant-Fazal Mohd. (respondent No. 2 herein) and injured-Mohd. Faroz (respondent No. 3 herein).

At the time of hearing, learned State Counsel, assisted by ASI Darshan Singh, points out that there are four nominated accused in the aforesaid FIR and the present petition has been moved only on behalf of two accused, therefore, on ground of partial compromise, no case for quashing of the aforesaid FIR is made out.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks permission to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
