By this common order, this Court intends to dispose of two
petitions i.e. CRM No. M-27875 of 2016 filed by *Lovekaran @ Anku and*
others and CRM No. M-27928 of 2016 filed by *Varun Kumar and others*.

2. CRM-M-27875 of 2016 has been filed for quashing of cross case dated 06.10.2015, under Sections 324, 452, 506 and 34 IPC (326 added later on) in case FIR No.240, dated 05.10.2015, under Sections 326, 452, 506 and 34 IPC, Police Station Ramamandi, District Jalandhar City (Annexure P-1) along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 05.10.2015 (Annexure P-2).

3. CRM No. M-27928 of 2016 has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No.240, dated 05.10.2015, under Sections 326, 452, 506 and 34 IPC, Police Station Ramamandi, District Jalandhar City (Annexure P-1) along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 12.10.2015 (Annexure P-2)

4. Report of Id. Judicial Magistrate has been received, in which, it has been categorically observed that compromise effected between the parties is genuine one and is voluntarily without any pressure, out of free will, duress or any undue influence. Even otherwise, the matter involved is personal in nature, which has been amicably put at rest.

5. So, in view of circumstances narrated above as well as the observations made in case reported as “***Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another,*” 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052** I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for the benefit of the parties and would certainly bring peace and harmony between them.

6. Consequently, both the petitions are allowed, FIR No.240, dated 05.10.2015, under Sections 326, 452, 506 and 34 IPC, Police Station Ramamandi, District Jalandhar City and all other consequential proceedings

arising therefrom including cross case dated 06.10.2015, under Sections 324, 452, 506 and 34 IPC (326 added later on) are quashed qua the petitioner(s).
