Report from the Court of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate Panipat received. As per the report, warrant of arrest issued for securing presence of appellant-Surender Singh received back unexecuted with the report that appellant-Surender Singh has expired. In pursuance of bailable warrant, surety Pradeep Kumar of appellant-Surender Singh also appeared before that Court and he also made a statement that appellant-Surender Singh had died on 16.11.2015. His statement was also recorded in the said Court wherein he stated that appellant-Surender Singh had died on

16.11.2015 in a road accident. Further he also produced photocopy of the FIR and death certificate. Photocopy of statement of surety Pardeep Kumar made before that Court is also annexed with the report.

Since the appellant-Surender Singh has expired, so this appeal stands abated. As a result thereof proceedings under Section 446 Cr.P.C. initiated against the surety of the appellant also rendered infructuous and no further action is required to be taken in this connection and the same are ordered to be dropped. Copy of this order be sent to the quarter concerned for strict compliance.
