The petitioner has preferred this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.328 dated 05.12.2014, registered at Police Station City Ferozepur, District Ferozepur, under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs & Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has undergone about 09 months of custody and no other case is pending against him.

However, learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sukhdev Singh, states that five witnesses have already been examined and one witness remains to be examined, who has been summoned for 06.10.2016. She further states that the prosecution will definitely conclude its evidence by 27.10.2016.

In these circumstances, the instant petition stands dismissed.
However, it is directed that in case the prosecution does not conclude its
evidence by 27.10.2016, subject to the accused not obstructing the same, the
trial Court shall release the petitioner on bail.
