This order will dispose of two applications for regular
bail, one (CRM-M-27903-2016) filed by Manjit Singh and the other

(CRM-M-27992-2016) filed by Reena Kaur, in a case registered on the basis of a secret information to the effect that the petitioners were members of a gang which indulged in the act of alluring the parents in need of money to sell their minor children on receipt of sum of Rs. 1,00,000/- to Rs. 3,00,000/- and further getting higher amount from the buyers.

No recovery was effected from the petitioners. Co-accused of the petitioners, similarly circumstanced, namely Manpreet Kaur and Baljit Singh, have been granted concession of bail by this Court on 17.08.2016.

Taking into consideration the fact that the petitioners have been in custody since 03.07.2016 and no recovery having been effected from the petitioners, they can be granted concession of bail on the principle of parity.

Both the petitions are allowed. It is ordered that the petitioners shall be released on bail on their furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of CJM/Duty Magistrate, Bathinda.
