By filing the present petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought regular bail in FIR No.12, dated 15.02.2016, registered under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 506 and 120-B IPC, at Police Station City-II Abohar, District Fazilka.

In pursuance of the order dated 23.08.2016, a draft of Rs. 2 lacs in favour of the complainant has been handed over to learned counsel for the complainant. The photocopy of the demand draft is taken on record as Mark 'A'.

The learned counsel for the petitioner on instructions from Samanpreet Singh, husband of the petitioner states that he will pay

another Rs.3 lacs within two months from today i.e. on or before 05.11.2016 and the remaining amount shall be paid on or before 31.12.2016.

In view of the statement made, without adverting to the merits of the instant case, this petition is allowed. The petitioner be admitted to bail during the pendency of the trial, on her furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds, to the satisfaction of the trial Court. The petitioner shall also surrender her passport before the trial Court and shall not leave the country without prior permission of this Court.

It is made clear that in case the amount in terms of undertaking is not made as per schedule, the present petition shall be deemed to be dismissed without further notice.

Anything said herein above shall not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
