The present petition has been filed by the petitioner for

issuance of directions to respondent No.2 to personally look into the representation dated 12.07.2016 (Annexure P-1) and for registration of a case against respondent No.8.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that respondent No.8-Daljit Singh @ Jeeta was earlier residing in the same street of the petitioner. He used to tease her and offered friendship. She refused him due to which he became inimical to her. Subsequently, he along with HC Kashmir Singh had lodged a case under the NDPS Act against her brother. In that case, brother of the petitioner was acquitted by the trial Court vide order dated 17.10.2015. The complaint has been marked to the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar. The petitioner is being harassed by respondent No.8 as he is a dangerous sort of person.

Keeping in view the submission made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Amritsar, to consider the representation (Annexure P-1) moved by the petitioner and take necessary action in accordance with law.
